

Middletown Regional Vocational Agricultural Education Program Retention Policy

Students enrolled in Agricultural Education must meet the following criteria to retain enrollment in the Agriculture Program. Failure to do so may result in dismissal from the program. Students who are dismissed from the program must return to their town of residence to continue their High School education if applicable.

Criteria for continued enrollment:

- Compliance with Middletown High School student rules and regulations as outlined in the student handbook,
- Abide by the FFA Code of Ethics,
- Successful completion of the classroom phase of instruction,
- Meet the Research Paper Requirement,
- Successfully meet the Supervised Agricultural Experience Requirement,
- Compliance with Middletown High School Attendance Policy.

Any student who violates the retention policy may be dismissed from the program. The parent/guardian will be notified in writing when a student is dismissed from the program. Any student who is dismissed from the program has the opportunity to request an informal review of his/her case before a review committee. Any such request must be made in writing within fifteen days of such action.

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
